



Sturgis Camaro Rally Autocross

Participant Information Form

The Sturgis Camaro Rally autocross is intended to be for fun. First and second place plaques will be awarded for each class. You must be 18 years old to race and possess a valid driver's license. Front seat passengers will be allowed if they have an event wristband and wear a seat belt. Passengers under the age of 18 must have a signed parental consent form that can be obtained at the autocross registration tent. Two participants may drive the same car (each must be a registered rally attendee or guest) or one participant can drive two different cars for an additional fee of \$35, but there is a limit of two drivers per car.

You must be checked in at the overall Camaro Rally registration and your car must pass tech inspection and be classified before autocrossing. See Technical inspection Form and Car Classification Form for details.

1. Classification Form – complete to the best of your ability. Any questions should be directed to committee members in the green shirts. Complete this form and return it to registration as soon as possible.

Technical Inspection Form – Complete the top portion, put a check mark in front of each item to confirm you checked it, sign and then take the form and your car to the Tech Inspection Area. Please remember to remove all loose items from your car before racing.

Speed limit anywhere within the parking lots while not racing is 5 mph. While racing, windows must be either fully up or fully down and no body part of either the driver or the passenger may be outside of the vehicle. Remember, safety comes first. If you sense anything wrong with your car or see something wrong with the track, just stop and you will be given another run. Also, if one of the track assistants is waving a red flag, stop immediately. Cameras, if used, must be firmly affixed to the vehicle. Hand-held cameras/cell phones are prohibited. **Burn outs to heat up your tires are strictly forbidden.**

Event officials reserve the right to terminate the event due to inclement weather or other dangerous conditions and also to disqualify a participant if they suspect they are driving under the influence.

See the event schedule below. There will be a Drivers' Meeting and one or two practice laps to allow participants to get familiar with the course. Each participant will have at least three runs to obtain their best time. Groups will run their laps in close succession so that you can enjoy some of the day away from the event should you choose. Penalties are as follows:

- Knocked down cone = 2 seconds.
- Cone outside of chalk box = 2 seconds
- Hit three cones, miss a gate or slalom or hit a "wall" = disqualified/did not finish. This will count as one of your runs.
- Cone touched but still upright and partially inside chalk box = no penalty
